



The Church Wellesley Neighbourhood Association Board invites all members to nominate candidates for the position of Board Director, Church Wellesley Neighbourhood Association. Directors must be members in good standing and live within the Church-Wellesley catchment area. Nominations can be made by:

- self-nomination
- nomination in advance by another member (nominated member must agree to serve if elected)
- nomination by another member at the Annual General Meeting (candidate must be present and agree to serve if elected) **Note:** *Due to the virtual nature of the election, there will be no nominations from the floor this year.*

Nominations must be received no later than 11:59 pm on Friday, November 26, 2021. Secure online ballots will be sent to all voting members following the AGM on the evening of Monday, November 29, 2021. Results of the election will be announced the following day, November 30, at 7:00 p.m.

Candidates will be invited to present a short statement (2-3 minutes) prior to the voting, but we also ask that candidates send a short statement about themselves to be circulated prior to the AGM. The candidates who receive the highest number of votes will be elected to open positions on the board. For members to be eligible to be nominated and/or vote for Directors, membership fees for 2021 must be received by the CWNA prior to the start of the AGM.
